Resolution 15 - 05

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING TRACTOR TRAILER TRAFFIC ON ALL ROADWAYS WITHIN THE DEVELOPMENT OF SILVERBROOK GARDENS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF A PORTION OF RODMAN ROAD.

WHEREAS, the residents of Silverbrook Gardens have for many years suffered disruptions in their cable television and telephone services because the cables and wires providing these services have been damaged by tractor trailer vehicles which utilize the roadways within this development as a cut through to make their deliveries; and

WHEREAS, these same residents are now being approached by the drivers of these Tractor Trailers and being told by them to move their legally parked vehicles because the Tractor Trailer is unable to negotiate a turn.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL, THAT:

- 1. Tractor Trailer vehicles shall be prohibited from traveling on any roadway within the development of Silverbrook Gardens with the exception of Rodman Road from the point where it intersects with New Road (Kirkwood Highway) to its intersection with "AC" Alley; and
- 2. That there be a No Parking Zone created on the Easterly curb line of Rodman Road from the point where it intersects with New Road (Kirkwood Highway) to its intersection with "AB" Alley; and
- 3. That no parking be permitted in that No Parking Zone between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm.
