Significant Events:

On the following dates/times Elsmere Bureau of Police officers handled the below incidents and seized the following drugs, money and/or weapons.

June 2019 Highlight's:

During the weekend of June 21, 2019, the Vilone Village are experienced an outbreak of motor vehicle thefts and thefts from motor vehicles. The Elsmere Police Department responded to these crime scenes and was able to process them in order to obtain possible suspect information.

While working in collaboration with other police agencies, also experiencing a similar outbreak of crimes in their jurisdictions, suspects were developed. At this time a total 7 juveniles from the City of Wilmington have been identified as being responsible for the crimes. At this time 75 charges have been files relating to Theft of a Motor Vehicles, Burglary 3rd Degree, Conspiracy 2nd Degree, Unlawful Use of a Credit Card, Criminal Trespass, Breach of Release, Theft Under \$1,500, and Felony Theft.

June 6, 2019:

On June 5, 2019, officers executed 2 search warrants. One in the 1300 block of Sycamore Avenue and the second in the Unit Block of S. Clayton Street, Wilmington, regarding the robbery that took place in Linden Park back on June 24, 2019. Based on information that was already obtained, two juveniles were both arrested and charged with Robbery 2nd and Conspiracy 2nd. One juvenile was released on unsecured bond, while the other was committed to Vision Quest.

June 11, 2019:

While on patrol, S/Cpl. Kerrigan located Henry (Hank) Wojnisz in the alleyway of Sycamore Avenue. Def. Wojnisz was taken into custody for Failure to Comply with the Sex Registry.

Def. Wojnisz was incarcerated at Howard R. Young Correctional Facility on \$1,000.00 secured bail.
